FAST FACTS about International Technology Law Association

1. What is ITeChLaw?

ITeChLaw is a membership-based association of lawyers who either concentrate their legal practices or are interested in technology law --- primarily information technology and telecommunications law.

2. Wasn't ITeChLaw known by another name?

Yes. In 1971 an organization called The Computer Law Association (CLA) was formed by a small group of lawyers who were practicing a new and unusual area of law that related to computers. Over the years, CLA grew – as well as the industry – and it was felt that a new name would better describe the association's modern mission especially with its significant international focus. As of January 24, 2006, CLA became International Technology Law Association with the nickname of "ITeChLaw" which is also our website address: www.itechlaw.org.

3. Member Profile

The majority of our members work in private law practice but we also have in-house lawyers, law academics, government attorneys, law students and industry representatives as members. Our membership is a highly international group of lawyers – as IT law is global by definition. We have members from 55 different countries.

4. What does ITechLaw do?
